HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATION 2019-20

All the parents / Guardians are requested to abide by the following rules and regulations in the interest of their son / daughter / wards.

VISITS

In order to help the new students to adjust themselves in a new environment, parents and guardians are requested not to visit the students till one month after their admission. During the school term, the parents are normally allowed to visit on the last Sunday of the month between 1:00 p.m to 4:00 pm. In no case parents should go directly to the students. Parents are requested not to meet their wards in their dormitories or study room. They should meet them in the Reception Hall/ lounge only after meeting the House wardens. No relatives, friends or guardians are allowed to see the students unless they bring an introductory letter with a photograph from the legal guardian. Parents are not expected to visit the child during school hours; however, they can be seated in the Lounge or Visitor's room to meet the subject teachers after taking prior appointment. Students are not permitted to meet the staff in their quarters.

LEAVE REGULATIONS

Students are not allowed to go home during the school term. Local Guardians are not permitted to keep the child overnight. They can meet the child on Last Sunday of the month 1:00 p.m to 4:00 pm. Students may be allowed a maximum leave of three days for the wedding of a real brother or a real sister. This leave will not be granted during examination days and during a study camp or on the day of an important activity. No cousin, uncle or aunts weddings would be entertained. Leave(s) may be granted for some particular treatment of the students provided the medical officer of the school recommends it.

In certain cases leave may be allowed for mourning or illness of a family member but parents should see that they apply for such leave only when it is absolutely necessary. For all leaves, request should be made to the Principal. No leave will be granted on the student's request. No leave will be granted on a request through a telegram / fax / e-mail unless there is something very urgent. The fax should be printed and not hand written.

Parents should not extend the date and the time when the students are to return after leave otherwise marks in the internal assessment would be deducted and a fine levied. If a child is detained due to some illness, application for leave should be accompanied with a medical certificate. Fine in all cases is applicable if school rules are not followed. No leave during Tours and Treks. They are a part of the curriculum and will carry 25 marks.

HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR BOYS AND GIRLS

1. For ordinary ailments parents are not informed, school will take care of it. If a student is admitted to the hospital, a communication is sent to the Guardian/Parents.
2. Students are not allowed to keep cash with them and no money is to be given or sent to the child. Parents should not send Money order, Birthday Money, Cheques, draft or any kind of gift for any reason. It is against school rules. Unauthorized money found with the boys / girls will be confiscated and credited to the Servant's Welfare Fund. Girls / Boys are given pocket money only on trips or on special outings when securing good grades only. Outings have to be earned. Test outings will be given initially. No private clothes of the boy / girl should be sent with the school kit.
3. Parents and guardians are requested not to call the students over the telephone. If there is anything urgent, the call should be made to the School Office, Warden or Housemaster. Call can be made from 4:00 p.m to 5:30 p.m. (S.T.D No. 0129). The telephone number for school is 0129 – 2345-405/407 (only School Time). For Hostel -0129-2345-ext- Class XII- 427, Class XI-429, Class X-144, Class IX- 413, Class VIII-411, Class -VI.VII- 454, Girls Hostel- 425, 450, Dorm A -459, Dorm B- 458.

4. Change of address & phone No. should be communicated to the school immediately in a separate letter marked "Change of Address" in bold. In writing to and for a student the letter must bear the Name of the student, Adm.No. and the name of the House.

5. Mobile phones are strictly banned.

6. Parents are advised to emphasize on their wards the need to observe all school rules and regulations. Violation of school rules and indiscipline may result in withdrawal of student from school and a fine to that extent.

7. Students must be honest during examinations. Students using unfair means will be given a zero. Any objectionable viewing with advancement of technology, intoxicants or the going to local dhabas or Video parlours , acts of misconduct , ragging , leaving school without permission are strictly prohibited for students. Students violating these rules will not be allowed to continue their studies in school.

8. School employees cannot be local guardians.

9. Only a parent can ask for leave. Applications should be addressed to the Principal mentioning Adm. No. and Name of the House. All travel arrangements should be specified and addressed to the Principal. In case escort is sent, due authority letter with the attested signature & photograph by the parent must be sent along with the escort.

10. Nobody would be allowed to go on "Self Escort ".

The Principal has the right to ask the parents / guardian to withdraw his ward from the school and hostel for misconduct for showing disregard to school rules, which have already been made known to them or for continued poor academic performance. A Statement of Undertaking would be signed by parents and their wards in such cases.

11. Parents may meet Principal taking permission in writing on a stipulated time (i.e. Second Saturday of the month between 1.00 to 4.00 p.m.) All Boys/Girls should respect the School Uniform and maintain its sanctity . Sunday meals are to be followed by a Dress code.

12. Emergency address and contact no. must be given by all parents. Security of the child is most important. No Vehicles would be allowed inside the campus.

Parents should sit in the conference room with teachers to check on the Child's progress on the second Saturday visit.

13. BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS: Parcels containing eatables are not allowed, Expensive parties to celebrate birthday are not allowed. On hearing from parents, school will sanction from personal account for toffees and sweets for distribution in class.

14. VALUABLES NOT ALLOWED: Electronic items, Record Player, Cell Phones, Cassette Players, Costly Articles (Gold ring/chain/other ornaments) are not allowed in possession of any Boarder. In case of loss of any such valuable or other article, the school shall not take any responsibility.

15. MONETARY AND OTHER TRANSACTIONS: No child is permitted to buy or sell or exchange goods or lend or borrow money from any staff or other child. Anyone found flouting this rule shall be treated guilty of indiscipline.

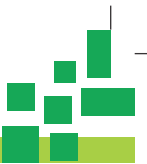
